*Megan Phelps-Roper grew up in the Westboro Baptist Church, a group famous for its intolerance, hate speech, and protests. She is now one of its rare defectors.*

*As the granddaughter of Fred Phelps, church founder, and daughter of Shirley Phelps-Roper, church spokesperson, Megan played a central role in spreading the church’s signature rhetoric to a global audience. In 2009, she started running the church’s Twitter account utilizing a unique blend of Bible verses, pop culture, and smilies, and that is when*

things started to change. Through calm and civil dialogue with strangers online, and later conversations in person, Megan began to question the convictions, assertions, and practices of Westboro she was born into and raised in. In 2012, she and her sister made the brave decision to leave their family and home, and renounce the teachings of the church.

Megan presented one of the top 10 most-popular TED Talks of 2017, in which she shares how empathy can overcome hate, tolerance can bridge ideology, and understanding and compassion can transform lives. Her upcoming memoir, *This Above All*, is soon to be released and is already set to be transformed into a feature film produced by Reese Witherspoon.
